

## PAYMENT OPTIONS

### DEARBORN HEIGHTS CITY HALL

Please bring the entire bill when making payment in person. The top portion can be kept with your cancelled check, which is your receipt. We accept payments over the counter in the City's Treasurer's Office. We accept cash, check and charge/debit cards. To pay with a charge/debit card, there is a 3% third-party convenience fee applied. The City of Dearborn Heights does not earn any revenue from charge card transaction fees.

### U.S. MAIL

Return the bottom portion of the bill with your payment and send to:

Checks are accepted as conditional payment. If the payment is not honored by the bank, the tax is considered unpaid and subject to both insufficient fees and interest. The Treasurer is not responsible for payment of wrong property descriptions. Any tax is voluntarily paid and cannot be refunded or adjusted.

All checks will be deposited the date after received. To avoid bank charges for non-sufficient or uncollected funds, have available funds in your account before writing your check. You are responsible for ensuring your check clears. There is a \$25.00 returned check fee.

### UPS or FED-EX SERVICES

Delivery must occur during business hours. Payments are processed on the date received. Penalties are not waived for failure of a carrier to deliver to us on time. Do not schedule deliveries on days the office is closed.

### DROP BOX

For your convenience, there are two drop boxes located at the Dearborn Heights City Hall. They are located at the front of the parking lot and to the right of the City Hall front doors (on the building). Place check or money order and your tax bill payment coupon in a sealed envelope and drop it in one of the designated areas. Your cancelled check or money order stub will serve as your receipt. DO NOT PUT CASH IN DROP BOX.

Follow the link to Pay Your Tax Bill. The first time, you will need to set up a free account. You may view your parcel information and pay property taxes. To pay by charge/debit card by phone, call Point & Pay at 855.340.4490. Taxes may be paid beginning July 1st through the last business day in February. You may not pay online or by phone after February 28, 2023.

THERE IS UP TO A 3% THIRD PARTY CONVENIENCE FEE FOR PAYMENTS MADE VIA INTERNET, DIVDAT OR BY PHONE WHEN USING CHARGE/DEBIT CARDS

### ONLINE BANKING

If you initiate your payment online through your financial institution, allow 2 – 3 weeks for delivery of your check to be mailed. To avoid delay, please be sure your bank payment is sent to:

## DIVDAT KIOSK

An easy way to pay property taxes, personal property taxes, water and sewer. Cash and Checks are fee-free. Debit/Charge card charges will apply. Safe, convenient locations throughout Metro Detroit. ### DIVDAT MOBILE APP

The Divdat Mobile Payment App is also available and runs on both Apple IOS and Android platforms. Search Divdat in your app store and download in order to make an e-check or charge card payment. Charges will apply. E-check is fee-free on Divdat.

### DUE DATES

Summer tax payments are only payable July 1, 2022 through August 15, 2022 without interest. Postmarks are accepted.

### INTEREST & PENALTY

From August 16, 2022 through August 31, 2022, ½ of 1% will be added. Beginning September 1, 2022, ½ of 1% per month will be added. Beginning March 1, 2023, taxes on real property can only be paid to the Wayne County Treasurer, International Center Building, 400 Monroe – 5th Floor, Detroit, MI 48226, with penalty and an additional 4% administration fee, plus 1% per month interest computed from March 1, 2023.

### INFORMATIONAL COPY

When requested, a copy of a tax bill will be sent to mortgage companies and the homeowner will receive an information copy of same bill. This tax statement is provided to you for informational purposes only. Please file it with your tax records. If you no longer have a mortgage company/escrow account, please call 313.791.3410.

### PROPERTY INFORMATION

#### VERIFY TAXPAYER INFORMATION

Report a change of address promptly. Failure to receive a tax statement does NOT exempt taxes from late charges.

### MILLAGE RATES

**City Operating and debt payments:** the total millage rate is 7.8460 mills

**Sanitation:** the total millage rate is 2.0596

**S. Waste:** the total millage rate is .9229

**Act #345:** voted on by residents in 1965 to provide a milage exclusively for Police and Fire Retirement System. The total millage rate is 7.5059

**Public Safety:** voted on by residents in 1974 to provide additional millage exclusively for police and fire protection. The total millage rate is 1.8460

**Library:** On November 5, 2013, the voters approved an additional .95 mill increase to fund the City Libraries. With the November 2, 1999 voter-approved levy, the total 2022 levy for libraries is 1.7245 mills

**Wayne County Operating Tax:** 5.6099 mills

**State Education Tax:** 6 mills

**School Operating:** this annual 18 mill rate (or less depending on school district) is divided half on this summer bill and half on the winter bill. 100% Principal Residence properties are EXEMPT from this tax

**School Debt:** rates vary per school district, depending on previous debt elections held within each district

**Additional School Tax:** Wayne/Westland - .4818 mills on both Summer and Winter bills

**Additional School Tax:** Westwood – 1.493 mills on both Summer and Winter bills

**Henry Ford College:** Dearborn School District only – both Summer and Winter bill will levy 2 mills
